Superintendent Klein gave the administration report. BK -12 student count for this year is 381 students. This is up four students from last year. The school car has a recall on it and one of the new busses has some needed repairs. The CTE project at Gregory Lumber will have some heating costs. Klein discussed the football program leaving the Great Plains Conference and read a letter asking the conference committee to let Gregory out of that conference. There is a possibility that a new conference may be forming. The board agreed and will bring it to a vote at the next board meeting.

Superintendent Klein also gave the principal report. She discussed the co-curricular activities that were in progress. Nov. 5<sup>th</sup> will be an early out for students and teachers will have an in-service day. Nov. 4<sup>th</sup>,5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> will be District Volley ball. On November 10<sup>th</sup> there will be a Veterans Day Program and no school on Nov. 11<sup>th</sup> to observe Veterans Day.
